Guide for Transcript Evaluation

Academic calendar

ESCP Europe operates on a semester basis. A semester consists of 14 weeks devoted to module instruction and examination. A year consists of two semesters : Fall and Spring. The Bachelor in Management comprises 6 semesters of study.

Conditions to be eligible for the Bachelor degree

Students must fulfill the following conditions:

- Validate 180 ECTS credits, that is achieving a minimum of 10 out of 20 in each of the programme modules.
Compensation between modules is not permitted.
- Acquire at least 20 weeks of professional experience over the course of the programme.

ESCP Business School GPA (grade point average)

Each semester, the student GPA is updated according to the following calculation:
Average of the final grades for validated courses weighted by the ECTS value of each course.

Honours

Depending on their results, students can receive their degree with Honours (when their final mark ranges between 13/20 and 15.5/20), or High Honours (when their final mark is equal to, or above, 15.6/20).
